Identity of the controller

Purposes and legal basis of data processing

Your personal data will be processed in order to execute real estate sales agreements.

Recipients of the data or categories of data recipients

The controller is the sole recipient of your personal data.

The data retention period

Your personal data will be stored for a period of time required for the execution of processing purposes i.e., data provided for purposes of a reservation agreement will be stored until the end of the reservation period, and in the case of a conclusion of a preliminary agreement or a final sale contract, data will be stored for a period of time required for securing rights arising under the contract. After the expiration of the periods of time stated above, the data is securely destroyed.

The right to limit processing

You have the right: to demand access to your personal data from the controller, to correct, eliminate or limit the processing, to object to the processing, and to transfer the data – *some of these rights might be limited subject to particular law regulations - in that case, the controller will inform you about the basis of such limitation.*

The right to file a complaint to a supervisory authority

You have the right to file a complaint to a supervisory authority in the area of personal data protection in the EU country of your ordinary residence, your place of employment, or the place of committing the alleged violation.

Information about freedom or obligation to provide data

Providing personal data is voluntary but required for the conclusion of an agreement with the controller. Failure to provide personal data may result in refusal to cooperate unless other regulations state otherwise.

Information about the transfer of personal data

The controller will not transfer your personal data to recipients in third countries or international organisations.

Information about profiling

The controller does not undertake any activities related to automated decision making about personal data, including profiling.
